7 Rules of Race

(1) Competition Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of the International Triathlon Union, JTU and local rules of the World Masters Games 2021 and specified in this document.

(2) Technical Delegate

Kosuke Furugo (ITU level 2, JTU Type 1 Technical Official) Director, Osaka Prefectural Triathlon Association

(3) Local Rule

① Competition: Distance and time limit

a) Standard: Time limit 4 hours / 54.6 km in total

- 1st run (9.6km): 1 hour 20 minutes to finish
- Bicycle (40km): 3 hours 20 minutes to finish
- 2nd run (5km): 4 hours to finish

b) Para-duathlon (Sprint) 2 hours 25.5km in total

- 1st run (3km): 40 minutes to finish
- Bicycle (20km): 1 hours 40 minutes to finish
- 2nd run (2.5km): 2 hours to finish

* If the competitor does not reach the goal after the time specified above from the start time, athlete shall be disqualified.

② The ankle band type JTU certified measuring chip to be distributed must be attached to one ankle. (However, Para-athletes is not in this rules)

The chip is a precision machine, it may be damaged if thrown or dropped, disabling the clocking.

The chip must be returned as soon as possible after use (after finish). If lost or not returned, a predetermined amount of money must be paid as compensation.

③ Certification of records

After verification by the technical delegate and the head referee, a record will become the official record. However, this does not apply when an appeal or protest is lodged.

9 Eligibility

■ Standard Event

(1) Domestic Athlete (Residents in Japan)

- The athletes must have a 2022 JTU membership
- The athletes must enter a JTU membership number (10 digits and 2 digits) at registration.

*Furthermore, prior to the JTU's registration start for 2022, the athletes must enter the membership number (10 digits and 2 digits) valid at the time of entry. After JTU membership registration for 2022 is completed, athletes must re-enter membership number at "registration status" of the entry system.

- Athletes must be "a finisher of the 2019 or 2021 JTU Age Group Ranking Race" or "a finisher of a duathlon race organized/co-organized/sponsored by JTU in 2019, 2020, or 2021".
- Additionally, finishers of the Suigo-Itaco Triathlon, Osaka Castle Triathlon, and Nagaragawa International Triathlon, in 2020 are eligible to participate.
- The qualifications for those with disabilities who participate in the standard event are based on the qualifications for the standard event.
- Please mark your record on the overall result of the qualifying events and upload it at the time of entry.
- If you are not a finisher of one of the qualifying events in 2019, 2020 or 2021, your entry will be cancelled.

(2) International Athletes (Residents in the other countries)

- The athletes must register for a JTU one day membership (registration fee: 1,000 yen)
- For international athletes who will register with JTU in 2022, the refund will be made at the athlete briefing on the Saturday 28th May (tentative).

■ Sprint (Para-duathlon) Event

(1) Domestic Athletes (Residents in Japan)

- The athletes must have a 2022 JTU membership
- The athletes must enter a JTU membership number (10 digits and 2 digits) at registration.

*Furthermore, prior to the JTU's registration start for 2022, the athletes must enter the membership numbers (10 digits and 2 digits) valid at the time of entry. After JTU membership registration for 2022 is completed, athletes must re-enter membership numbers at "registration status" of the entry system.

- Please enter the name of the completed event in the domestic / overseas paratriathlon / triathlon/duathlon race in 2019 ,2020, or 2021.
- Please mark your record on the overall result of the completed event and upload it when you enter.

(2) International Athletes (Residents in the other countries)

- The athletes must register for a JTU one day membership (registration fee: 1,000 yen)
- For international athletes who will register with JTU in 2022, the refund will be made at the Athlete briefing on Saturday 28th May (tentative).

10 Consideration for persons with impairments who participate in the Standard event.

The content of consideration according to types of impairments is the following:

Persons with hearing impairments

- **Consideration for providing information on a bulletin board.**
The race status shall be broadcast and displayed on the bulletin board.
- **Arrangement of sign language interpreters.**
Sign language interpreters will be allocated.
- **Accompaniment of a person to help an athlete with impairments**
A helper will accompany an athlete with impairments to the field of play area before and after the race.

Persons with intellectual impairments

- **Consideration to provide easy-to-understand explanations**
Provide easy-to-understand explanations of the competition rules.
- **Accompaniment of a person to help an athlete with impairments**
A helper will accompany an athlete with impairments to the field of play area before and after the race.

11 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31 December 1992)

In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group, with your age determined as at 31 December 2022. For example, if you are 39 during the event but have turned 40 by 31 December 2022, you would compete in the 40-44 age category.

12 Medal Ceremony

The medals will be awarded to the first, second and third-ranked athletes by event, gender, and age category or classification.

13 Registration Fee

(1) Entry fee (including tax and handling fee)

- ① Competition participation fee (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)
 - a) Overseas athletes: 24,000 yen/person
(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic athletes: 15,000 yen/person
(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
- ② Persons related to the race (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas athletes: 14,000 yen/person
(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic athletes: 5,000 yen/person
(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

*When a helper (a person who supports an athlete with impairment participating in a race) participates in the race for providing such support, he/she is required neither to apply for participation in the race nor to pay a registration participation fee (however, the helper must apply for participation as a competition when he/she requires a kit for participating in the race, a transportation pass and others).

(2) Extra fee

- JTU one-day-registration: 1,000 yen

For the international athletes, the fee need to be paid at *the Entry System* during registration.

If the athlete who registered JTU in 2022, we will refund this fee at the Athlete Briefing

(3) Rental fee for race equipment, etc.

None (Race equipment cannot be rented.)

14 How to Apply for Entry

Application is made through the entry system on the official website (Entry System) dedicated to the application for the entry to the race via PC or smartphone.

15 Notes on Participation

(1) Uniform/ Outfits

- ① The race uniform must conform to the ITU competition rules.
 - ② Domestic athletes must wear the national team uniform of the World Masters Games 2021 Kansai designated by the Japan Triathlon Union. Each participant will be notified of how to acquire the uniform. However, international athletes with Japanese nationality can choose to wear the national team uniform. JTU-approved uniform for the 2019, 2020, 2021 Age Group World Championships and Multi-Sport Championships will not be permitted to wear.
 - ③ Athletes will wear appropriate outfits for the Athlete Briefing, opening ceremony, closing ceremony, and medal ceremony.
- (2) Equipment
- ① Race equipment must conform to the rules stipulated in the ITU Competition Rules and JTU Competition Rules, as well as the rules agreed to this event.
 - ② The athletes can check-in their bikes on 28 May.
 - ③ The bikes to be used shall be a road racer or TT bike.
 - * Mountain bikes, cross bikes, T-bar cross bikes, city cycles are not allowed
 - * A "road racer" is a drop handle type bicycle that prioritizes high-speed driving performance. The mudguard and stand must be removed.
- (3) Guides and handlers
- Athletes of "TRI6 (visual impairment)" who participate in the sprint (para-duathlon) section must arrange a guide of the same gender. Players who need a handler must make their own arrangements.
- (4) Registration and Athlete Briefing
- Each athlete who has completed the registration procedure on the day before the race must be subject to the check-in on the race day.
- Each athlete must participate in the Athlete Briefing held on the day before the race.
- * If an athlete fails to participate in the Athlete Briefing, he/she will not be allowed to participate in the race.
- (5) Insurance

- (6) Doping Control
- ① The doping control in accordance with the [World Anti-Doping Code](#) and [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) shall apply to this race.
 - ② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#).
 - ③ The athletes are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with [the rules of the International Masters Games Association](#) upon entry to the race. The athletes are advised to check [the rules](#)

of the International Masters Games Association Rules for more details.

- ④ This race aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.

(7) Procedure for Bad Weather

If adverse affects of bad weather are expected to conduct the race, the start time, courses, etc., may be changed, but no extra day is provided.

(8) COVID-19

17 Others

All participants must complete the Games accreditation and the registration at the race venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a race.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the race. (Proxy registration will not be allowed.) Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.
