*An athlete cannot participate in a younger age category.

*A team age category is determined by calculating total ages of members.

*An athlete can participate up to 3 team events.

*No limits for individual events. However, depending on the progress of the competition, you may not be able to participate in all of the competitions you select.

*For Ocean M relay a team (4 people) must consist of the same gender. No mixed gender is allowed.

*A Team event can be mixed from different teams and countries. Team names can be made but should be a decent and simple one. The team does not necessarily have to wear the same cap but should wear their own individual(team) cap. (Although, Teams are preferred to wear the same cap if possible.)

9 Eligibility

The athlete must be a member of a certified life saving club.

10 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 25 (born on or before 31 December 1997)

In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group, with your age determined as at 31 December 2022. For example, if you are 39 during the World Masters Games but have turned 40 by 31 December 2022, you must compete in the 40-44 age category.

11 Presentation Ceremony

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third-placed athletes for each category.

* Depending on the category, there are awards only for 1st and 2nd places.

12 Registration Fee

(1) Competition participation fee (including tax and handling fee)

① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)

a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person

(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)

b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person

(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

* A competitor can compete in 5 disciplines including Lifesaving within the same registration fee. There are 59 disciplines altogether in the World Masters Games 2021 Kansai.

* For Lifesaving a competitor can compete up to 3 team events but individual events are not limited.

* However, depending on the progress of the competition, you may not be able to participate in all of the competitions you select.

② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)

a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person

(Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)

b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person

(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

14 Notes on Participation

(1) Clothing

(2) Competition equipment

(3) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to “injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues” of the “competition participants and persons related to the competition”, and does not cover all kinds of risks during the competition. Therefore, all persons taking part in the competition are requested to subscribe to required insurance at own risk and costs.

- ④ This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete the accreditation process personally by 21 May 2021. (No exception will not be allowed.) Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete the accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.
